# ON COURSE NEWS

Aerification Process Performed in November:


Jesse Martin, who is an expert in the aerification process with many courses throughout the area relying on his team and equipment, he stressed that a process of a deep core aerification and an overseeding will help immensely on what can be expected in the spring of 2025. This is what we performed in November.

The aeration we perform is called core aeration. It involves using a machine to tear out plugs (or cores) of turf. This process rips apart roots and makes small holes in the turf. At the same time, the machine ejects the plugs of turf & soil to your lawn surface. These will gradually decompose and return the nutrients to the soil.


These holes benefit the course in several ways.

- 1. They open compacted soil, allowing more oxygen, water, and nutrients to get to the roots. Soil that is too compact does not absorb water and nutrients as well. It can cause water runoff and drainage issues. It also stifles grass growth because nutrients, including oxygen, cannot reach the roots.
- 2. They encourage new and deeper root growth because the roots will expand and fill those empty areas. Strong grass roots are important to the long-term health of your lawn. A good root system can help protect your grass against disease and drought.
- 3. **The holes help reduce lawn thatch.** Although some thatch is a protection, too much thatch serves as a barrier preventing air, water, nutrients, and fertilizer from reaching the soil. A heavy thatch layer suffocates the course.


